# **Team Information Package General Information**

# Follow the tips below for an enjoyable day:

# **Etiquette**

- All participants are expected to treat the officials, organizers, volunteers, their fellow competitors and spectators with respect. Any abuse of this fact witnessed during the festival is to be reported to the organizing committee who will review the situation and take appropriate action that may include expulsion of a participant or crew from the festival.
- All teams are expected to respect the rules and regulations of racing and the judgment of the officials. Un-sportsmanlike towards the officials in this regard may bring about further penalty and risk disqualification the infracting crew.

# Preparing for day

• The event starts at 10am (registration by 9;30am). Please be prepared to stay until after the event which should end about 1pm. One late person (or someone leaving early) could affect the outcome of your teams start/finish.

# General

• The overall management of BizBash shall rest with the executive committee who shall be the supreme authority over all matters pertaining in any way to the event. The executive's decisions and rulings shall be final on any group or individual concerned with the decision.

### Safety

- It is strictly forbidden to consume any kind of alcoholic beverage before or during event. Any participants caught consuming alcohol before having completed all his or her activities will be immediately barred from further participating and risk their elimination of their team from the event.
- Any participants injured or who become ill during the BizBash are to report to medical staff immediately. If the condition is serious, medical staff may restrict a participant from continuing in the activities. Their decision is final.
